



Just a Note

Who Needed Technology?

Growing up in Lyndhurst, I had cousins, aunts and uncles, and grandparents living in the same town as us. It was a blessing ... and a curse. There were no cell phones back in the 1950's but somehow, word from a relative always quickly got to my mother, especially if one of her three kids did something stupid. I can still picture Mom standing on our front stoop waiting for me, as I walked up the street, and she'd have her hands on her hips. "Hands on hips" was NEVER a good sign and that sight would automatically trigger my *Self-preservation Plea Bargaining*. Sometimes I won my case ... and sometimes I was without television for a week. No television! Augh! Cutting off my right arm would have been more merciful.

And speaking of television; my parents never needed the luxury of a remote control. They had their three children sitting on the floor, right in front of the tv set! Whenever mom or dad said, "Somebody put on channel 2." (... or 4, 5, 7, 9, 11, or 13 - there were only seven tv channels back then.) one of us would get up and turn the channel knob really fast to the desired channel. This was immediately followed by a voice from the couch - "Stop turning the knob so fast!! You're going to break it!" And if we did break it, Dad was there to fix it.

My dad repaired almost everything in our house. If the television wasn't working, Dad would remove all the tubes from the back of the tv set, drive down to the hardware store and test each one until he found the 'bad one'. If our washing machine was broken, he'd take it completely apart and fix, or replace, whatever was needed. Yup, Dad would tackle any broken appliance, bike, or toy. After he'd completed his Mr. Fix-It task, ALL TOO OFTEN there'd be leftover parts, which Dad said were "extra parts that weren't really needed." Mom convinced him to hang onto those parts 'just in case', and over the years the 'Spare Parts Box' in our basement got bigger and bigger. Luckily for Dad, after his repairs were done, the washing machine did work fine, and we did get a picture with sound on the television, so apparently, he was probably right! But there was that one time he fixed my bike; I wouldn't get on it until my brother Eddie gave it a test ride. Yup, that was unfortunate for Eddie ... obviously some parts weren't 'extra'.

Another part of technology missing from our youth was the internet. We didn't have websites like Google or "Ancestry" to find out about our family's history. We didn't need it. We had Wednesday nights with my Aunt Rita, her sister Helen, and my mom. The three of them would sit at the kitchen table, and over a fresh perked pot of coffee and a *Brown Derby* cake from Mazur's Bakery (or crumb cake from Joe's Bakery), they would exchange endless stories about our relatives and the "old days". These family stories fascinated my sister Lynda and me, and we would sit at that kitchen table hanging onto every word. Naturally, just when they'd get to the really good stuff, we'd be sent to bed. Now, we lived in a small apartment, and our bedroom was right next to the kitchen, and on the nights that our aunts visited, we'd leave our bedroom door cracked open just enough to be able to hear them. We'd lie in bed with our eyes closed, listening to their conversation and picturing each story that became scenes in our mind. Nowadays, we'll rehash the 'old family secrets' that we overheard from the kitchen table ... something you can't (and wouldn't want to) find on the internet.

Thanks to technology, these days I have so much information at my fingertips, but I'm kind of glad it wasn't around while I was growing up. Then again, SOME technology would have been welcomed – like Dad being able to Google instructions for bike repairs! Again, sorry, Eddie!



IMPORTANT INFORMATION

S R P NORTH HOMEOWNERS

ARCHITECTURAL COMMITTEE

Prior to obtaining a permit from the Berkeley Township Construction Office and/or Zoning Office, homeowners must obtain a "Architectural Approval Request " form from the Architectural Committee. Sheds, upgrades, renovations, repairs, additions, exterior changes, anything pertain to the grounds, trees, driveway construction and sidewalks all require approval from the Architectural Committee. Note: Homeowners may need to submit a Zoning Permit Application, required fees, and forms to the Berkeley Township Town Hall/Zoning Office. Contact the Zoning Office for instructions.

COMMON GROUNDS

No debris, grass cuttings, landscape material, leaves, old plants, tree branches should be dumped in the common grounds. Violators are subject to Berkeley Township fines.

LAWS GOVERNING S R P NORTH

Mandatory Federal, NJ State, Berkeley Township Laws, SRPN Association Covenant-Restrictions and By-Laws and Robert Rules are instruments of the rule of law that the sitting Board of Trustees must follow to meet their obligations.

- Title VIII of the Civil Rights Act of 1968 (Federal Fair Housing Act)
- The Housing for Older Persons Act (HOPA)
- NJ State Public Law #L90-284 and PUB 100L430 Guidelines for the operation of senior communities.
- Berkeley Township Ordinance #118-1625. The establishment of a planned residential community for older adults.
 Silver Ridge Park North's Covenants and Restrictions/By-Laws.
- State of New Jersey Full Disclosure Act and Regulations Title #5.

SELLING/RENTING OF HOMES

When selling your home, either on your own or through a Real Estate Agent, you must notify the HOA <u>BEFORE</u> your buyer completes the 'New Purchaser's Packet' and provide the HOA with two (2) forms of identification; one being a photo ID showing birthdates for <u>each occupant</u> of the home. (See pg.2 for appt. information) SRPN By-Laws require one (1) year homeowner's ownership prior to renting their property.

Landlords AND Tenants must complete the HOA's 'Lease Agreement Packet' and provide the HOA with two (2) forms of identification; one being a photo I.D. showing birthdates for each occupant <u>and</u> a copy of the Lease.

All buyers and tenants (all residents) must appear <u>in</u> <u>person</u> at the HOA office with the required identification and paperwork. Berkeley Township will not issue a C.O. (Certificate of Occupancy) without the HOA's Letter stating the buyer/tenants are in good standing with the Homeowners Association.

SIDEWALKS

It is each homeowner's responsibility to repair and maintain sidewalks on their property. All lifted and cracked sidewalks require repair at the homeowner's expense.

TREES

It is the homeowner's responsibility to prune and maintain trees located on their property. Also, no tree in the common ground, or wildlife corridor, may be pruned, removed, or topped for any purpose, including installation of solar panels. Trees in these areas needing attention should be brought to the attention of the Common Ground Trees Committee.

OTHER IMPORTANT REMINDERS

- Parking/storage of inoperable, unregistered, or uninsured motor vehicles, boats, or any other watercrafts, trailers, and/or recreational vehicles are not allowed anywhere on your property or Common Grounds.
- Berkeley Township Ordinance: Trash/garbage
 is to be put out at the curb <u>AFTER 4:00pm</u> on
 the day before a scheduled pickup. RECYCLED
 ITEMS are to be placed curbside, in reusable
 containers or <u>paper</u> bags, <u>AFTER 5:00pm</u> on
 the day before a scheduled pick up.
- All pets are required to be leashed. You must pick up and remove your pet's waste, even if you walk them in the common ground area.
- It is the Homeowner's responsibility to maintain their grass and/or stone lawns.
- A Berkeley Township Ordinance strictly prohibits the feeding of wild animals consisting of, but not limiting to, the following: DEER, rabbits, squirrels, chipmunks, and groundhogs. Wild birds are excluded.

Silver Ridge Park North Shed Rules

After discussion regarding sheds at the Silver Ridge Park North (SRPN) Trustee meeting, held on Tuesday, April 7, 2015, the Trustees unanimously agreed to Rules 1-8. Updated Permit/Form information - February 2019.

- 1. In keeping with Berkeley Township's Shed Ordinance, homeowners are permitted, effective this date, to install one (1) shed on their property; up to and including 120 square feet (10 ft. x 12 ft.);
- 2. Said shed may be of any structure material the homeowner desires;
- 3. Sheds that are required to be fastened must be on a firm ground structure. DO NOT place any shed on a cement slab. Cement slabs add square feet to your taxable living space and will be taxable by Berkeley Township;

- 4. Sheds may NOT be installed on any Common Ground Property;
- 5. In accordance with Berkeley Township Ordinance, sheds must be placed at least three (3) feet from the back property line and at least (3) feet from the side property line;
- 6. If a homeowner chooses to install a shed adjacent to their home, it may NOT block any windows or doors;
- 7. Homeowners MUST submit an Architectural Approval Request form to the SRPN Architectural Committee. *Architectural Approval Request forms are available in the SRPN Clubhouse Lobby*;
- 8. The homeowner MUST submit a **Zoning Permit Application**, required fees, and forms to the Berkeley Township Town Hall/Zoning Office. *Zoning Permit Application forms can be obtained from the Berkeley Township Website or Zoning Office*.



- If you see anyone feeding the deer, call the HOTLINE (phone number above).
 Simply give the address of the person violating the Berkeley Township
 Ordinance and a Representative will pay them a visit.
 - If the report is valid, the Violator will be given a First/One Time Warning. If the Violator chooses to ignore the First/One Time Warning, a SUMMONS WITH A \$500 FINE WILL BE ISSUED.
 - If they choose to continue feeding the deer, they will be FINED AN ADDITIONAL \$500 FOR EACH VALID OCCURRENCE REPORTED.
- Deer are wild animals, not pets! There are Animal Shelters full of dogs and cats that need love and nurturing. If you'd like a pet, please consider adopting one from an Animal Shelter and save a life.
